Module III – AJ 222A – January 9-March 17, 2018 • Estimated enrollment cost \$700

Additional required equipment: uniforms

Module II – AJ 222B – March 20-June 28, 2018 • Estimated enrollment cost \$1285

Additional required equipment: law enforcement equipment belt, flashlight, plastic replica firearm, actual firearm (semi-automatic 9mm or 40 cal.)

Module I – AJ 222C – July 6-December 6, 2018 • Estimated enrollment cost \$1800

These are the only orientation dates scheduled. All interested applicants **must** attend the orientation on one of these dates. The orientation will explain the selection process and provide an overview of the course. The POST Entry Level Law Enforcement Test Battery (PELLET B) reading and writing test will be held immediately after the orientation.

If you have taken the PELLET B test at the Training Center or another location within one year of the start of the academy, you do not need to retest if you scored T-42 or higher. You must bring a copy of your results to the orientation.

If you intend to transfer into Level II or Level I from another institution or from an earlier year at SRJC, contact Kelly Ransbottom at least 2 months before the start of the class by emailing kransbottom@santarosa.edu or calling 707.836.2909 to receive restrictions and special requirements.

The class will be held at the Training Center in Windsor. All of your travel, transportation, and accommodation arrangements should be made with this in mind. When you consider enrolling in this class you:

- Must complete the course orientation at a scheduled orientation session or meet in-person with Director Marvin.
- Must possess a valid driver's license at the time of the class.
- Must pass the PELLET B Test with a score of T-42 or higher by the start of Module II. Must present photo ID at the time of testing.
- Must be eligible to register as a student at Santa Rosa Junior College without a waiver of College regulations.
- Must pass a California Department of Justice criminal records check (cost varies).
- Must pass a medical examination by the start of Module I.
- Must be a high school graduate or possess a GED certificate.
- Payment plans are available for levels I and II only and must be approved by the Academy Director.
