<b>Pre-Test Qualification Requirement:</b>	<p><b>B-8 Shooting Assessment – Overview</b></p> <p>The B-8 target assessment is a standardized marksmanship evaluation commonly used in law enforcement and firearms instructor programs to assess a shooter's precision, control, and consistency under time constraints.</p> <p><b>Target: B-8 Bullseye Target</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5.5-inch black scoring area</li> <li>• Scoring zones: X, 10, 9, 8, and 7 points</li> <li>• Maximum score per string: 100 points</li> </ul> <p><b>Course of Fire (Timed B-8 Assessment):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Distance: 10 yards</li> <li>• Firearm: Duty handgun</li> <li>• Total Rounds: 10</li> <li>• Time Limit: 10 seconds</li> </ul> <p><b>Scoring Requirement:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A minimum score of 80% (80 points out of 100) is required to meet the qualification standard.</li> <li>• Failure to meet this standard may result in disqualification from the instructor course.</li> </ul> <p><b>Agency-Approved Handgun and Shotgun</b> (with sling, if applicable)</p> <p><i>If your agency does not issue a shotgun, one can be provided upon request.</i>  <i>Note: The Sig Sauer P320 platform is currently <b>not permitted</b> for use at our facility.</i></p>
