Course Description:	This is an intensive 40-hour study of advanced investigative techniques as they relate to the enforcement of California anti-cruelty and neglect laws. Students should be prepared to conduct a mock investigation, take photographs ( <b>bring your own camera</b> ), write reports, collect evidence, work collaboratively with a team, and testify. Students will be asked to report on an agency investigation or animal issue.
Required Textbook:	California Animal Laws Handbook, 2020 edition. Book can be purchased at the Marin Humane the first week of class. Please note: The 2020 edition may not be available until January.
