RE: Course Description and Certificate Completion

In 2012 Santa Rosa Junior College (SRJC) earned Federal accreditation for its Ranger Academy as an approved National Park Service (NPS) Seasonal Law Enforcement Training Program (SLETP). This allowed NPS to issue a Type II Law Enforcement Commission Certificate to graduates who meet all NPS standards. This certificate is in addition to the established SRJC 17 unit Certificate.

Subsequently, the official SRJC course description for AJ 203 was changed to read: “basic law enforcement training program accredited by the Federal government to certify graduates for employment in National Parks and/or regional and county parks.” This approach allows students who are unable to satisfy NPS standards the opportunity to complete the course and earn the SRJC Certificate, which is recognized by numerous regional and county park employers.

The NPS graduation requirements defined in the newly named Park Ranger Law Enforcement Academy (PRLEA) Training Standards Handbook including conduct, integrity, and earning 70% or higher on all exams, will continue to apply to all students. The only points of separation will be in firearms and arrest/control tactics Practical Evaluations (PEs). Students who do not meet these NPS standards are ineligible for the NPS Certificate but may remain eligible for the SRJC Certificate.

To be clear, only students who complete the course and meet all NPS standards will be awarded both SRJC and NPS Certificates.

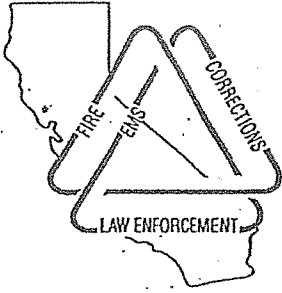

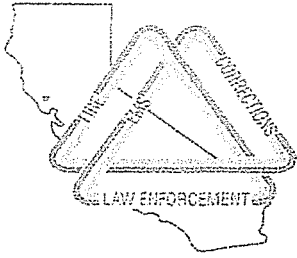

In this connection, I authorize the Santa Rosa Junior College/Public Safety Training Center Academy staff to release any and all information that they may have concerning my record at the Academy.

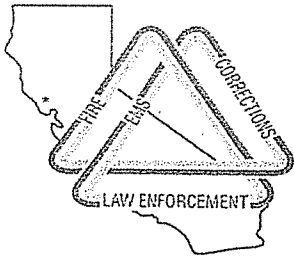

### DISCRIMINATION

It is the goal of the Public Safety Training Center to train students in the basic techniques of Public Safety. In order to accomplish this objective an academic environment must be maintained at all times during the Academy to insure the learning process is equal for each student. For this reason any conduct which creates an atmosphere which is not conducive to the high standards of the Academy will not be condoned nor tolerated. Such conduct includes, but is not limited to the following:

1. Any conduct or action which limits or denies a person or group of persons opportunities, privileges, roles, or rewards on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, ancestry, sex, age or disability.
2. Unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors and other verbal or physical misconduct of a sexual nature.
3. Any type of conduct which might be construed as harassment toward a student when such conduct has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an individual's performance or creating an intimidating, hostile or offensive academic environment.

Any student who feels that they have been the victim of sexual harassment or discrimination must report this to the Academy Director, as soon as possible after the incident. The Academy Director, in conjunction with the District Compliance Officer, will then begin an investigation of the incident. The Director will prepare a written report of his/her findings and recommendations.

It is the policy of the Public Safety Training Center that any type of discrimination, general or sexual harassment toward a student will be subject to firm disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the Academy.

Each student should be mindful that the primary mission of the Public Safety Training Center is to train each Academy student to the highest level of their individual potential. This can only be accomplished if each member of the Academy functions as part of a team toward this goal.

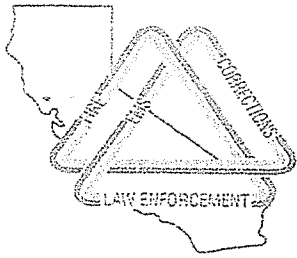

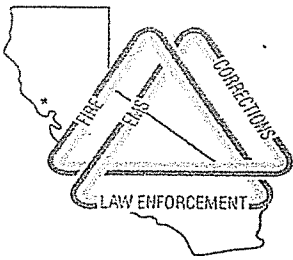
